Native Congress in Durban

On Monday the 4th Instant the Native Location in Durban was the scene of a large conference of Natives.

The meeting was held at the school room but it was early seen that the large numbers could not be accommodated in the small room.

The exceptional large numbers were remarkable considering the rainy weather.

After the usual preliminaries the president, Rev. J. L. Dube outlined the scope of The Native Affairs Act, 1920.

The new Act is the first serious attempt by the Government to meet the wishes of the natives.

All the pros. and cons. of the Act were fully and fairly discussed and questions were asked and answered.

The point was however raised that the present Native areas are too small for the present and future needs of the Natives.

The meeting showed that the Native is willing to meet the European when the right hand of fellowship is extended to him.
