I have enclosed my written work about the black people of Africa and whence they came from and have also distinguished various tribes of this country. I would therefore appreciate if you could assist me in this regard by giving me the best information you have about their relationship and distinction. It starts from no.25 up to where it talks about Mnyamana's tribe. We and the children of the King are still in good health condition and would be very glad if we can hear from you. It is quite a long time since we parted and we all remember you.
