THE ANNALS OF NATAL; 1495 to 1845; by John Bird; 2 volumes. Bound in cloth, £2 2s.; in half-calf, £3 3s.

THE STORY OF THE ZULUS, with illustrations; by J. Y. Gibson, for some years a Magistrate in Zululand. 7s. 6d.

NATAL: An Illustrated Official Railway Guide and Handbook of General Information; compiled and edited by C. W. Francis Harrison (Published by Authority); with over 250 illustrations and several Maps and Plans. 6s. 6d.

THE ZULU IN THREE TENSES: Being a Forecast of the Zulu's Future in the Light of his Past and his Present; by Robert Plant, Senior Inspector of Native Schools, Natal. 5s.

THE HISTORY OF OLD DURBAN, AND REMINISCENCES OF AN EMIGRANT OF 1850; Illustrated. 6s. A most interesting record, kept by George Russell, who left England in May, 1850, and arrived off Natal early in July of the same year. Notes of the leading people and descriptions of the social and civic life are given, year by year, up to the end of 1860.

NATAL: the Land and its Story; by Robert Russell (10th edition); with Maps; 3s. 6d. The first quarter of this work deals with the Physical and Political Geography of the Colony, and with its Climate, Flora, and Fauna, giving also a sketch of those features of the neighbouring Colonies. The main portion of the book is devoted to a simply-written, but fascinating history of Natal.

THE NATIVES OF SOUTH AFRICA: Their Economic and Social Condition; edited by the South African Native Races Committee; with an appendix of 86 pp., giving replies, received by the above Committee from leading men on various aspects of the Native Question; 15s.
