Bright, who was then 2nd in command in Baseado land, under Mr. Griffith. The officials were allowed to keep weapons surrendered to them, Mr Bright kept these. I can not say that every stick in

the bundle was his, but I think the spears in the quiver certainly were; there never were arrows in it. Langakibalele's own battle axe was there too - that is now in the possession of my niece Dorothy, Mrs Skuse.
