WOOD VESSEL: in the form of two large ovoids, communicating through a small hole, with a large outer ring linked to these ovoids by six elbow-joints, and supported on four feet. The whole surface is heavily grooved, and darkened with hot iron. There are no lids; the wood grain is vertical.
