SMOKING-PIPE: A water-pipe, for smoking dagga or hemp, consisting of a length of horn, the larger end plugged with wood secured by furniture studs, the other end left open, and with two staple loops for a suspension cord. A short length of reed supports the grey stone bowl, which is decoratively grooved.

L (of horn) 23.4 cms

L. (of bowl) 6.3 cms

DI (of bowl) 5.2 cms
