GOURD VESSEL: A waisted-necked gourd ornamented with blackened quatrefoils, triangles and eightlobed "windmills", the blackened areas also ornamented with inset white seed-beads. Two bands of incised cross-hatching enclose the two rows of triangles. The stopper is made of a mealiecob with black and natural coloured leaf covered knob with twined fastening on top.
