BEADWORK: Panel, predominantly of navy blue and turquoise beads with an overall pattern of lozenges outlined in white and four large red lozenges outlined in white and navy blue.

L: 66 cms

W: 8.5 cms

(NGUNI, probably ZULU)

This type of beadwork is called Ulimi, or 'tongue' and is worn suspended round the neck.
