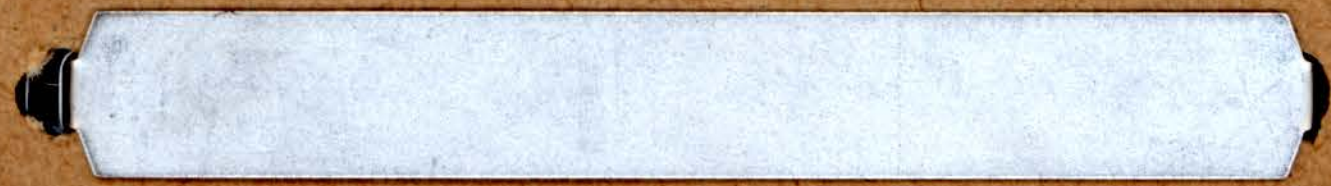

Description: *Crossbar*: Rectangular, slightly curved and sloping to one side. Decorated on upper side with a line incised from front to back.

*Lugs*: Flat rectangles facing sides, one is split along what appears to be the grain of the wood.

*Column*: Single, flat, front-facing rectangle.

*Base*: Rectangular, flat underneath and rounded on top, with a short, rectangular pillar at each side; the right one has pink, green and orange beads embedded in an oval on its outer side.

*Base*: Two, linked, slightly convex circles.
