Description: Crossbar: Rectangular, unevenly curved, and decorated near the flattened narrow ends with a short row of incised zig-zags.

Lugs: Short flat triangles with apexes down, facing front. One has a hole pierced through it.

Column: Three roughly rectangular pillars, blackened at sides.

Base: Two flat, roughly circular pieces linked at centre.

Comments: This piece is roughly and unevenly carved.

Column: Four roughly circular pillars fusing just below half-way to form two pillars at base. The two middle pillars are joined at the centre by a cylindrical bar.

Base: Two flat circles joined at the centre by a short, rectangular bar.
