ATB261 One of the largest clans originally and a high reputation as iron workers. Their country extended from the eTalen hill away to the banks of the Mzinyati. Had many related minor clans. In the days of Dingiswayo the chief was Macingwane

To page 273 Bryant describes their flight under Macingwane from Shaka, his death the return of his sons Wfusi and Pakade, Shaka's assassination of the former the heir, Pakade's removal from Dingane's rule to an area in Natal between the Tugela and Mooi rivers, Mpande's attack on them when he was with the Boers and the succession of Pakade -(d1880) Gabangaye - Silwane - Muzocitwayo.
