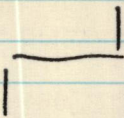

Conscripted under Dinagna (Ndhlela was the induna of his regiment) and Mpande. Fought at Maqongao ~~Ndxxxx~~ / "The Kanyile are part of Cunu people - originally a beast was killed the insonyama was cut out also an umlenze. ~~Kxxxx~~ Kanyile & Mcunu were called to pick whereupon Knayile took umlenze as he had a large number of people, whilst Mcucu took the insonyama, having fewer people. In consequence ~~the~~ ^{this} Mcunu became our great chief and Kanyile the lesser one.

Kisi ka Mandondo ka Dube ka Mqumbela ka Denga ka Bulu ka ^Ramatshe are the Kanyile heads. Macingwana ka Jama ka Mcunu are the Cunu chiefs. "Kisi died near Bayne's drift. Mandondo where the Golokodo stream enters the Mhlatzue high up. Informant i s related to t is line.
