 After Death of Dingiswayo the presence of the Ndwandwe drew Shaka's attention he favoured his 'father' Mbiya (Mmbila) - a cousin of Dingiswayo to whom he had become attached during his exile. The tribe favoured Myaka a half-brother, he 'demurred', and another half brother was appointed Mondise. Then they were attacked by Zwide and put to flight. After Shaka had beaten Zwide he killed Mondise and the sons of Dingiswayo still being too young he appointed the son of his favourite, the cousin, who had also been a companion Mandela. Dingane presented him with two of his sisters, Nomzintlanga and Nomcoba, daughter of Nandi. Mpande presented him with three daughters of S'kona: ~~Sokwetshata~~ <sup>Nomquoto</sup> who became mother of the heir Sokwetshata, Ndlebezomlilo, Somcuba, Gijima, and Nomaklwa. Thus the Mtetwa clan, first by its own power, then by prudent submission, continued in undisturbed possession of its ancient homeland, while almost every neighbouring clan had been desolated or destroyed."

S P Notes on a history of Zululand

"28/12/01 Per Ndukwana The chief Somkele is the son of Mayanda (Maldna) who was son of ~~My~~Veyane (Velane), and this Veyane was the great Dingiswayo's induna. the present chief Sokwetshata is the son of Myandeyz (Mlandela) son of Mbiya of Tshangana. Sokwetshata's ~~tribe~~ tribe is the Mtetwa to which ~~D~~ Ndukwana belongs though his father went to live in another part of Zululand. Sokwetshata is ~~in~~ of the Mxapo remgimen, ntanga ka ~~Zix~~ Zibebu Ndukwana fancies the Mtetwa tribe was about the first to settle in Zululand. Ngqengelele & Mtshana came without (had no) isizwe, they had no imizi. The Ndwandwe tribe was the last to Kansa The Ndwandwe tribe was caused to move from Umhlatuze to a spot further north. An isbongo of an Umtemtw man would be wena was'ezansi - you of the south or lowlying country. The seat of the tribe was originally just below the junction of White and Black Umfolosi and on the south side at a ~~px~~ spot spoken of as Ezibwanwini.
