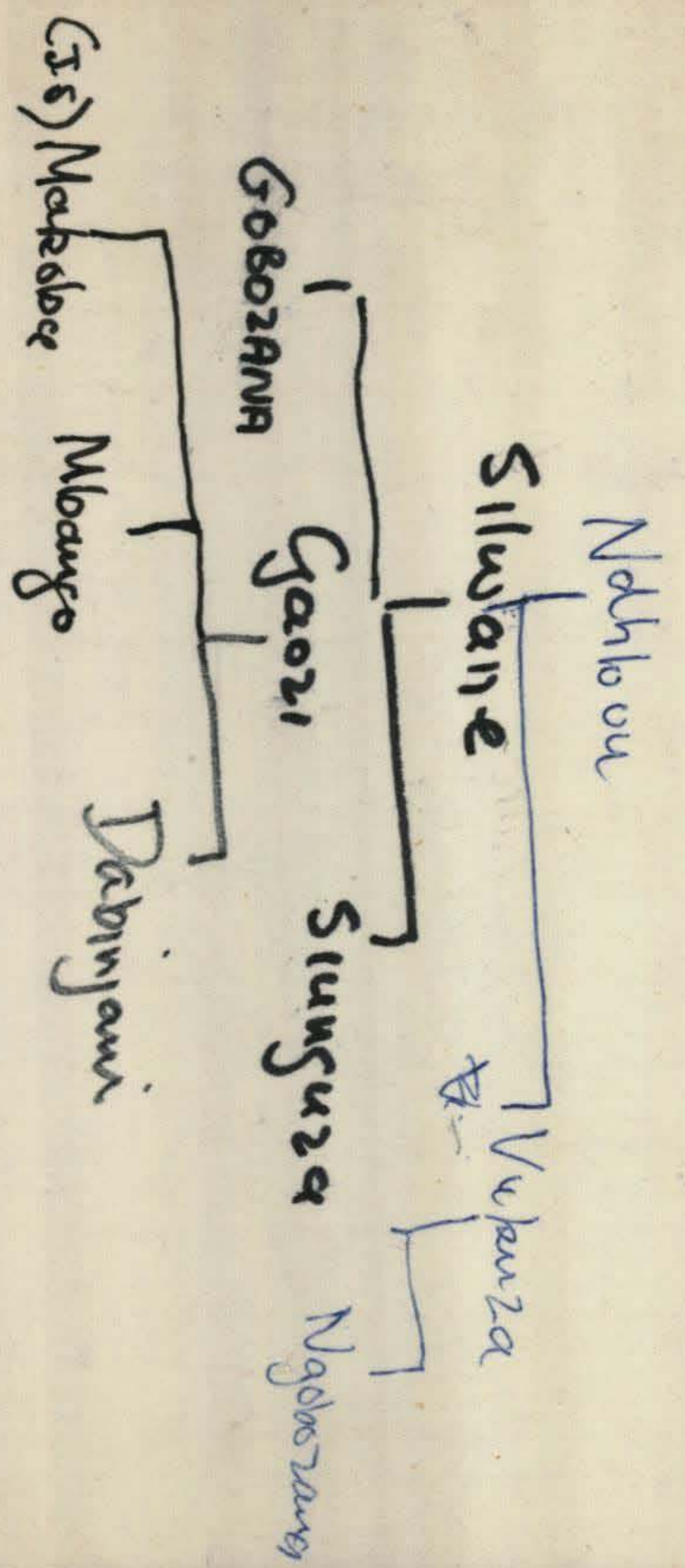
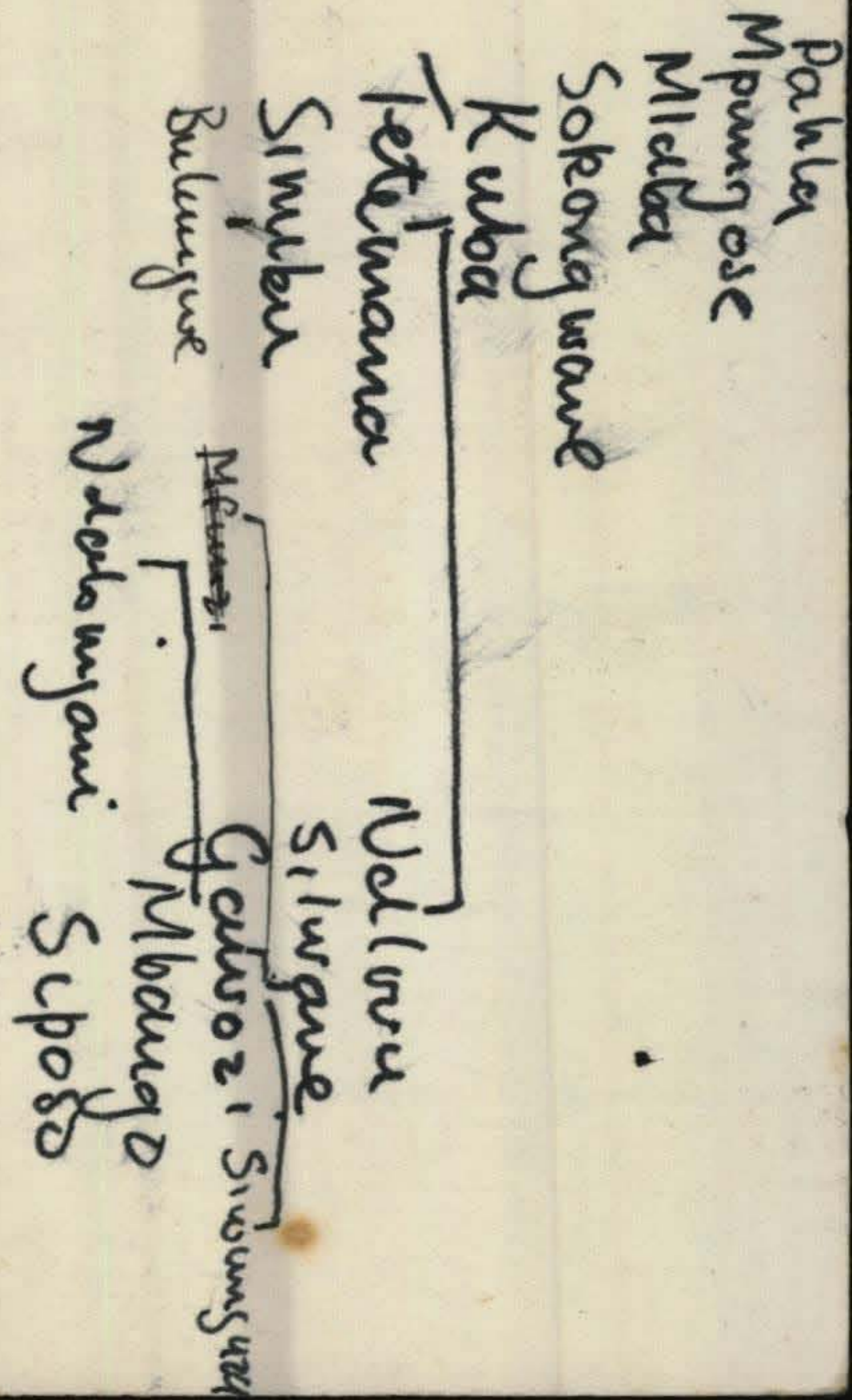
Mpungose, the son of Pahla, a domestic of Zulu was raised in favour and given territory near the eTaleni hill. "The present head of the clan is said to be Bulingwe, of Sinuku, of Tetemana, of Kuba, of Sokongwane, of Mlaba, of Mpungose. Ndlovu the son of Kuba probably during Shaka's time moved into territory which had been Cunwini, next to the Sikakane at eTaleni hill. His son Silwane found favour with Mpande and he became headman of the area between the Mfule and Mfolosi. His son Gawozi (Gawazi) was appointed over a portion of 'Qwabeland, north of the upper Mlalazi and was succeeded by his ikohlo son (Ndabinjane) was heir Mbango then Siposo followed.

Great amaqawe of Tshaka were Mapita Mkanyile Ntshingwayo ka Marole Vumandaba ~~is~~ Dazukile Tshoko Diyik₂na Nkabana My uncle Ndhlovu belonged to one of the first regiments - Senzangakona's Ndhlovu / "My father Silwana qala'd umhlanganiso eMaqongqo. Umvundhlana ka Menziwa kwa Biyela qala'd umhlangansio kwa yo kwa Ndwandwe, Magidi ka Menziwa of Biyela tribe, also qala'd umhlangansio kwa Ndwandwe. The same of Myakayaka ka Ndosi wa kwa Mahayi, qala'd umhlangansio ku Nomveve, Ndosi ka Nondumo, wa kwa Nzuzu, qalad umhlangansio ku Noveve kwa Ndwandwe, Mpezeni ka Gala wa kwa Biyela, qala'd umhlangansio ku Nomvemve in the action with Ndwandwe,.... he Mgumgundhlovu kraal was first built eVuna and was close to Gqikazi & Mbelebele kandas. " /the latter on the north bank under Ingweqwe hill and the former on the south bank - this was in inagne's day.

The Mpungsoe originated at Nhlazatshe and one kraal kwa Qwata puma'd ku Mbokojwana whislt at Nhlazathse. Qwata kraal was at Mfule and this is whhere Siwane puma'd. Ndhlovu had the falling sons: Silwana Mpihlela Vukuza Nomnanzi Nkwali Boya Msutu Dwabiyane. Mpungsoe is the name of an ancestor and we sprant from the Zungu. We are intimately associatated with the Zulu scribe.... / "a s the follwing story weill tell. In

Sezangakona's day, there was fighting, as there was always fighting among the tribes, the cause of it being dispute to heriship." / Zulu put to flight but Z's daughter left behind and my ancestor Kuba discovered her and broght her to S. his good act ~~xxx~~ / "Upon this a real and lasting alliance was cemented between the Mpungsoe and the Zulu tribe which has lasted to the present day."

The faction fight referred to was between Z'Kona and Mkasana ka Jama Kuba supported S after rescuing the girl and with the assistance of Ndhlovu defeated Mkasana. S at the time had no followers and but with Biyela help decided to fight the Cunu so Kuba and his son Ndhlovu went with him and defeated the Cunu and ~~hex~~ Ndhlovu was given a tract of country viz Etaleni. then they attacked Kabatshe wa kwa Zulu and Ndhlovu on their victory was given Xulu territory. then S and N died and Tshaka succeeded.

R Robertson - J Shep 9/1/80 / Gaosi died on 5/1 and as he had been a friend of Rob's for 20 years he went to the kraal. The people not knowing what to do he told them to report it and he would write the letters. Rob recommended that Siunguza (Gaosi's bro) be appointed Regent and Guardian of Undabinjani (the heir) and the people said this is just what they had proposed amongst themselves. Siunguza is one of the best Zulu Rob knows /

W't - Bul 12/1/89 / Official report. Says that Gaozi named his son to him as heir. He is about 30 . W't recommends that he assume the chieftainship and moves the kraal at which his father died in Dunn's territory.

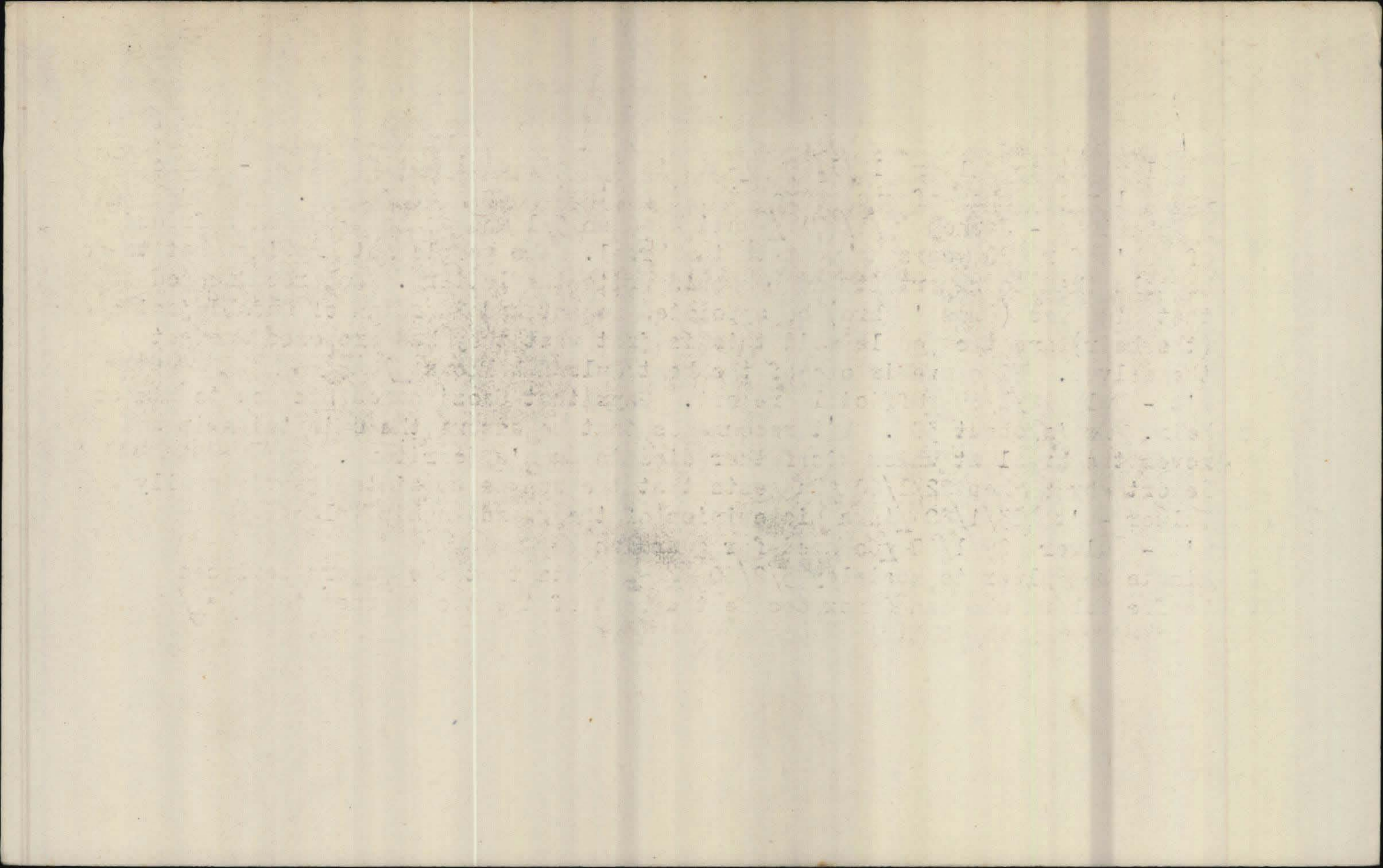
