Wondi ka Silwana ka Mangcengeza ka Matomela ka Tshisa ka Dzana ka Mdhlovu ka Zuma.¹

I am of Zuma *isibongo*. We are of Basuto race. We live *up the iLovu river* at Byrnetown.² I and others of our tribe live on Cunningham's farm.

Notes

¹ The names are those of members of the Zuma (Nxamalala) chiefly house.

² Byrne village is situated ten kilometres north-west of Richmond. The incident which sparked the first phase of the Natal rebellion of 1906 took place nearby.
