"Ukuvela kwama Ndlambe," was written by the AmaNdlambe chief Nathaniel Cyril Mbala, a former student of Jonckheere College, St. Augustine, Canterbury. I got a pamphlet about his life, his picture is there + my father's, - I shall send it to you to see it, if you care. The cuttings, I believe, are from the "Izwi Labantu" which paper he was then editing. The chief died in 1921 leaving one daughter + no son.
