Dear Sir, -

1. I am somewhat afraid and ashamed to have to come to you again for a loan of Three pounds ten shillings (£3.10.0); but as circumstances are I choose to fall into your hands rather than into other men's. Please Sir, as soon as you can, send me this amount, it will be of great help, and in time of need.
2. I herewith enclosed a letter, from the Assistant Native Commissioner of East London, re my daughter Valentia's Scholarship.
