We would have preferred the usual royalty basis, particularly as we fear we are to suffer considerable loss on the old orthography edition, only about one-half of which has been sold. The rest of the stock may be left on our hands. We find we have paid you about £8 on the first edition. In all the circumstances and in order to meet you we are ready to pay forthwith a further sum of £25 for all rights in DON JADU.
