Dear Mr Bennie,

Your letter of 14th regarding Mr Mqayi is to hand. I shall be pleased if he will sign the Agreement regarding DON JADU and get this old difficulty out of the way. I may add, however, that I cannot understand how he was under any misapprehension as to what the Agreement meant, as I personally discussed the matter with him at length, and the matter was further explained in various letters sent to the firm of lawyers whom he brought into the case. I enclose the Forms of Agreement.

The signing of the agreement regarding DON JADU does not, of course, bind us to the publication of the Life of Mr Makiwane, which must be considered on its merits and with regard to our present and future commitments.
