Dear Mr. Mqhayi,

I am sorry there has been considerable delay over the question of the printing or publishing by us of your MS. ULWALUKO. I found considerable diversity of opinion as to whether the Lovedale Press should take the lead in this matter and so reserved the question for consideration at a full meeting of our Press Committee. The meeting was held on Monday, 23rd instant, and after considering the subject in all its bearings, the Committee came to the conclusion that before we could accept this work, either as printers or publishers, the matter should be fully ventilated in the principal churches and also in such a body as the Christian Council and some form of unanimity reached. At the present time the subject is a highly controversial one and the right method of approaching it at this stage seems to be through the churches and Christian bodies rather than through a publication of the Lovedale Press. I am therefore returning your MS. under separate cover.
