The Nkhosi people at Moelebeleni stemmed from the Royal kraal at Shiselweni. King Somhlolo sent out his wife LaMnini and gave her this kake share of Mbelebeleni as her share. Her first born son who was a chief was Mantinti I, followed by Mthenga; third was K Velebantfu; fourth was Mantinti II who recently died.

It was just a common thing that the king used to distribute land amongst his children and so this land was given in that manner. To start with, that is before we came here, the land was under Mnyamane an indyna by the surname of Nhlobatsi. He was Mantiniti's induna. We are not sure if there were any other clans, but as you may remember if a place is under an induna, who is not a Dlamini, and if at any time the king sends his child to that particular place the induna, no matter how great he is, falls under the royal blood.

The name of tix the place is Mbelebeleni. It was the first Mantinit i's village. When the king went up to Mdzimba Mantiniti went up with him, but he returned to this place which had been already offered to him - as a share for his mother. In fact Mantinti never set fool alivein the this area. The personwho came here to rule was Mthonga, who was from that side of the border fence at Velozizweni. But Mantinti I was buried at Mbilaneni, then Mthonga came to this place. It was during the time of the return of the princes to Velozizweni that Athonga was instructed to go back to his xm own area at the rock here at Mbelabeleni.

The Lubuya battle vetwerans are: Malokoma Gulivo, Duda Shabalala, Zondwako Shongwe. Then it was the days of the Mshadza and Hulu wars. It was by the kines hand as alies of the english. It was during the days of Mthonga. He was also a brave man. Velebantfu was a chief during the days of King Moandzeni.

Envemene - was the son of Malimane, who was sent by the king from Shiselweni to look after this land which was given as a share to Mantinti's mother Lammini for theking. Then at the death of Malimane Mnyamane remained at Mbelebeleni looking after the land. The queen arrived at the indunes village. But later the queen went to Velezizveni where she died.
