Note: we arrived in some haste, and late,
and appeared not to be well-received. A large
no. of men were assembled at the Shiba
unipakatsi (± 15) and it was not clear who
were possible informants. This interview was
an exploratory exercise to indicate who

had info. & once that was estab. we
arranged a further meeting with 4 possible
informants. Our difficulties during the
interview were compounded by Henry's
ill-manner towards the Shiba, & what
I interpreted as gross abruptness on
his part. Apparently, this has to do
with an old history of personal antagonism.
