KWABULAWAYO SURVEY

As a result of the recommendations in my report on the survey of Shaka's capital kwaBulawayo, Mr L. O. van Schalkwyk asked me to submit a budget for the completion of the survey for consideration by the KwaZulu Monuments Council (KMC). This project is envisaged as a joint venture by the Natal Museum Institute for Cultural Resource Management and the KMC. I have prepared the budget using the guidelines that shaped the budget for the initial stage of the project. These are:

1. In order to save on costs, the KMC will provide a vehicle for my use in and around Eshowe. Transport costs in the Eshowe vicinity are based on petrol costs of R2 per litre, 70 km of daily travel and an estimated consumption of 12 litres per 100 km.

2. The KMC will pay the costs incurred by Institute personnel on trips to and from Pietermaritzburg. These costs are calculated at the KMC rate of 71,9c per kilometre plus the toll costs. I have budgeted for two return trips.

3. On completion of the fieldwork, I will process the raw survey data at the KwaZulu Survey Department in Mpumalanga and have budgeted for 5 trips to Mpumalanga at 82c per kilometre.

4. Subsistence costs will be met by the KMC at the standard KMC rate of R24.00 per day.

5. The KMC will provide a caravan which will be parked at the Eshowe caravan park.

6. Two assistants will be employed and paid at the KwaZulu Government rate of R25.00 per day.

7. I estimate that the completion of the survey will take 30 days, 25 of which will be spent in the field. Should the project be completed in under 30 days, the Institute will charge only those costs it has incurred.

I hope the budget is satisfactory and look forward to hearing from you soon.

Dear Barry/Alan and Len

Enclosed is the interim report for the Bulawayo project, based on the fieldwork done in 1994. I recognise it is a year since I completed the 1994 fieldwork, but stress that it was never my intention to submit an interim report. Rather, I intended to submit a final report once the survey had been completed. Accordingly, the invoice submitted in November 1994 was only for those costs incurred during the fieldwork. In fact, I only received formal notification that KMC required an interim report in June or July 1995.

I have recently returned from a further period of fieldwork on the site and have incurred the following expenses:

I would appreciate it you would send me a cheque to cover these costs. If this is not possible, I shall claim the money from the Natal Museum. However, this would mean that the KMC would have to pay VAT on this amount when I submit the invoice for the 1995 fieldwork and report.

During the fieldwork last month, I had a conversation with Nkosi Sam Zulu who raised a couple of issues that have significance for the future development of the site as a tourist and educational resource. He expressed concern at my 'loitering' around on the site (despite the fact that I had sought and been given the go-ahead to work on Bulawayo at the court). He also mentioned that there

are local plans to construct a secondary school, a soccer field and a clinic on the site. He was clearly concerned that the work I was doing was in some way going to result in the land being taken from his/the local communities control. I strongly recommend therefore, that any plans to develop Bulawayo should involve extensive consultation with the local community. I shall address this more extensively in my forthcoming report.

BUDGET FOR THE KMC BULAWAYO SURVEY PROJECT

We are very interested in the proposed archaeological survey of Bulawayo and its satellite sites including Nandi's grave. The project has much to contribute in the fields of both archaeological and historical research. In particular it has the potential of extending the detailed work on royal Zulu settlements at Ondini and Mgungundlovu further back in time. We therefore look forward to cooperating with the KwaZulu Monuments Council in this project.

Following previous discussions between representatives of the KMC and ourselves at the Natal Museum, we are submitting the enclosed budget as a proposal for your approval. The survey is envisaged as a joint project between the Natal Museum Institute for Cultural Resource Management and the KMC. It will be carried out mainly by staff of the Institute and funded by the KMC.

Our budget is drawn up on the understanding that:

- 1. the project will be divided into two phases: an initial Phase 1 feasibility survey (9 days) and a longer Phase 2 survey (2 months), after which a full report will be submitted.
- 2. in order to save on costs the KMC will provide a vehicle in Eshowe for use by Institute personnel in and around Eshowe. Transport costs in the Eshowe vicinity are therefore based on petrol costs alone (at 12 litres per 100 kilometres) and an estimated 30 kilometres between Eshowe and the site. In addition, the KMC will pay the costs incurred by Institute personnel on trips to and from Pietermaritzburg. These costs are calculated at the KMC rate of 71,9c per kilometre plus the toll costs. During Phase 2 four return trips will be made between Pietermaritzburg and Eshowe.
- 3. subsistence costs will be met by the KMC at the standard KMC rate of R55.00 per day.
- 4. the KMC will provide a caravan which will be parked at the Eshowe caravan park.
- 5. the KMC will help in the recruitment of an assistant from the local community. The assistant will be paid R25.00 per day as per KwaZulu Government rates.
- 6. surveying equipment suitable for surveying a large site such as Bulawayo will be provided by the KMC from their existing equipment.

We look forward to hearing from you in the near future.
