Trench 1 78/142 Notting found

Trench 2 78/143 1 bone reddened ~~quartzite~~, 1 bone brown (decayed)
3 trach. beads

Trench 2 east 78/144 2 bone pieces greatest 'decayed'

Trench 2 west 78/145 1 small native shell + 1 scrap bone. Decayed

Trench 3 78/146a 0-10 cm. scraps of charcoal (decayed)
39 Small native shells intact shape, 7-12 mm thick
and \approx < 3 cm across

1 plain native shell 6 cm across

1 small shell with 2 -row of horizontal
lines + above them a line of diagonal markings

60 Scraps of Bone (one, some charred), + 1 tooth
of (and small bone)

1 light pink trach. bead

1 small straw fiber, with signs of sticking on both faces,
probably quartzite + perhaps much older than the

beads, no significant shape

1 scrap of fused clay or ceramic

Trench 3 78/146b 10-20 cm.

A considerably number of medium or small bones of bone,
a good many probably recognizable, but + general
feeling rather. 240 pieces counted. A few charred,
some seem to belong to my small animals

16 pieces of tooth, some + probably all bone

19 small adrenostatic native shells

1 native shell with -row lines

2 small trach. beads

2 Bean-like seeds probably w/ nodes

Trench 3 78/146c 20-30 cm

1 fair-sized native shell

1 scrap bone

1 large quadrangular fibula (perhaps flattened fragment)

Dingao's kraal, Dugaaanstat

Waste school June 1978. Low hut area, (not far back - trenches)
 Trench 3 78/146d 30-40 cm. 2 small water sheds

Trench 3 ext. 78/147a 0-10 cm 1 small water shed
 1 broken tooth

Trench 3 ext 78/147b 10-20 cm
 60 small + medium pieces of bone, a few
 recognizable
 1 broken tooth
 12 small water sheds + 1 medium piece, thick
 unornamented
 1 scarf of plain rounded wire
 1 pale pink translucent bead

Trench 3 ext. 78/147c 20-30 cm

1 white quartzite bubble, almost certainly used for
 jewelry
 1 flint bubble, may have been used for jewelry,
 decorated
 7 scarfs of bone
 3 scarfs native pottery

I think there is a response of some kind to the
 iron to the right.
