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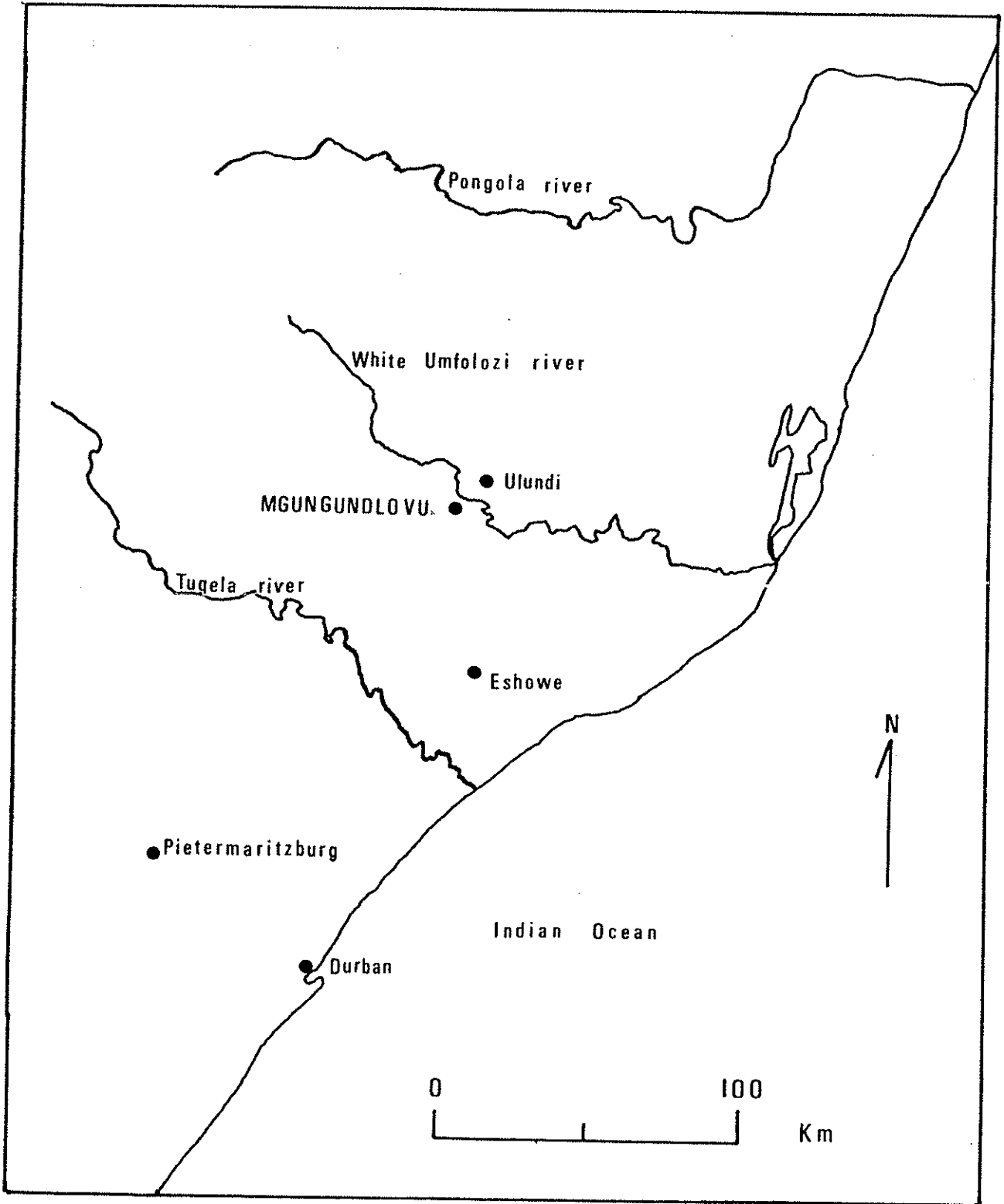


Fig. 1 Natal : Location of Mgungundlovu

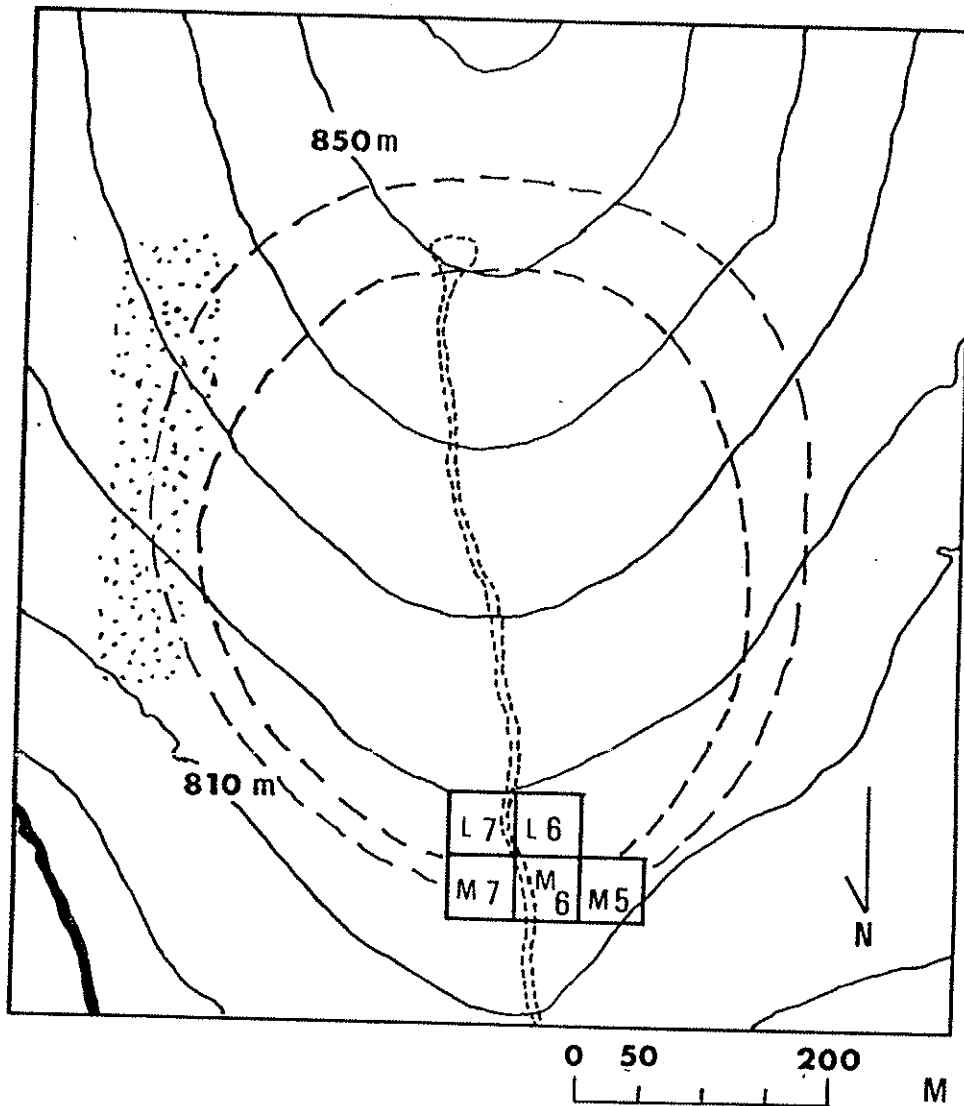






Fig. 2 Location of excavations

-  Approximate outline of capital

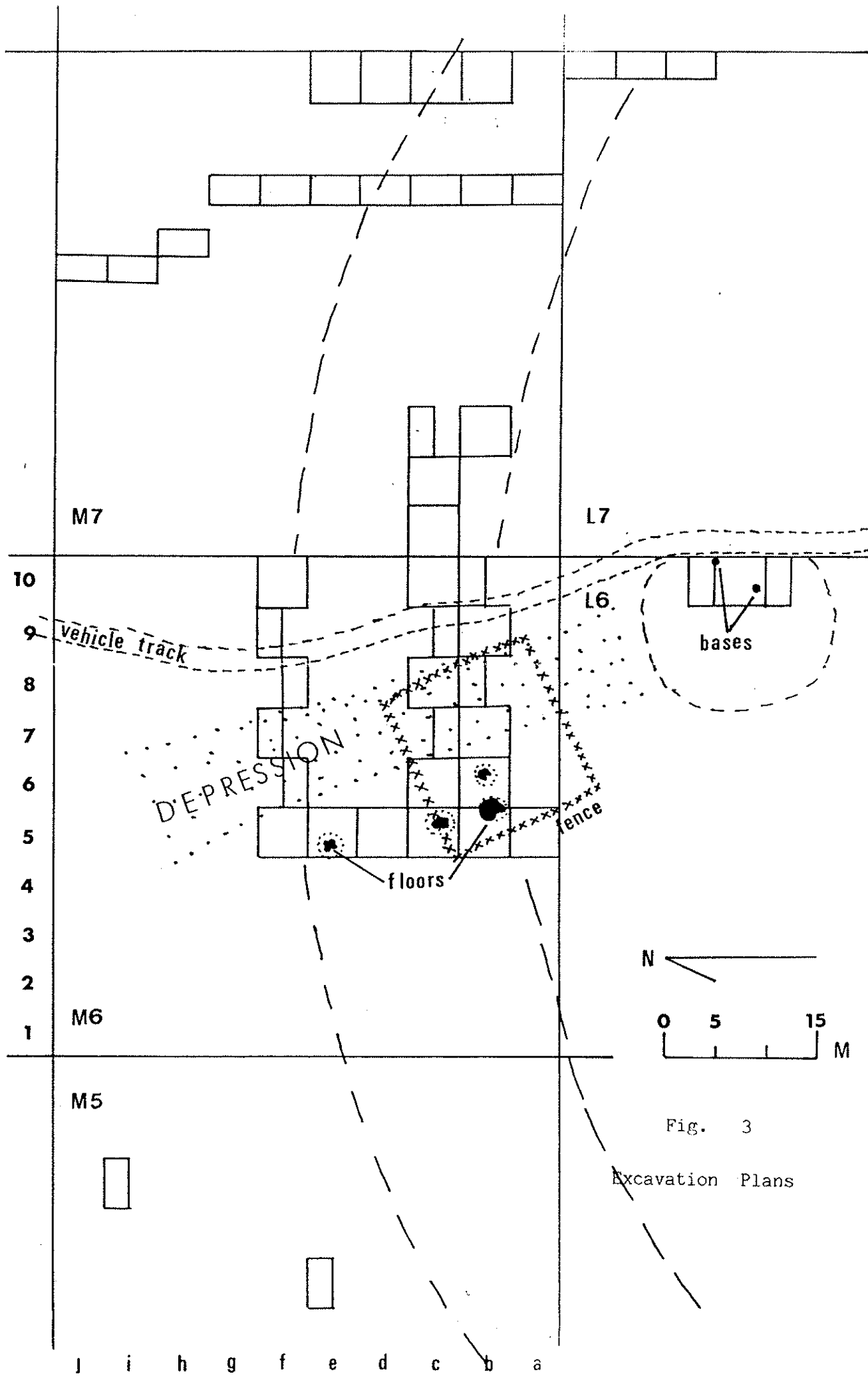

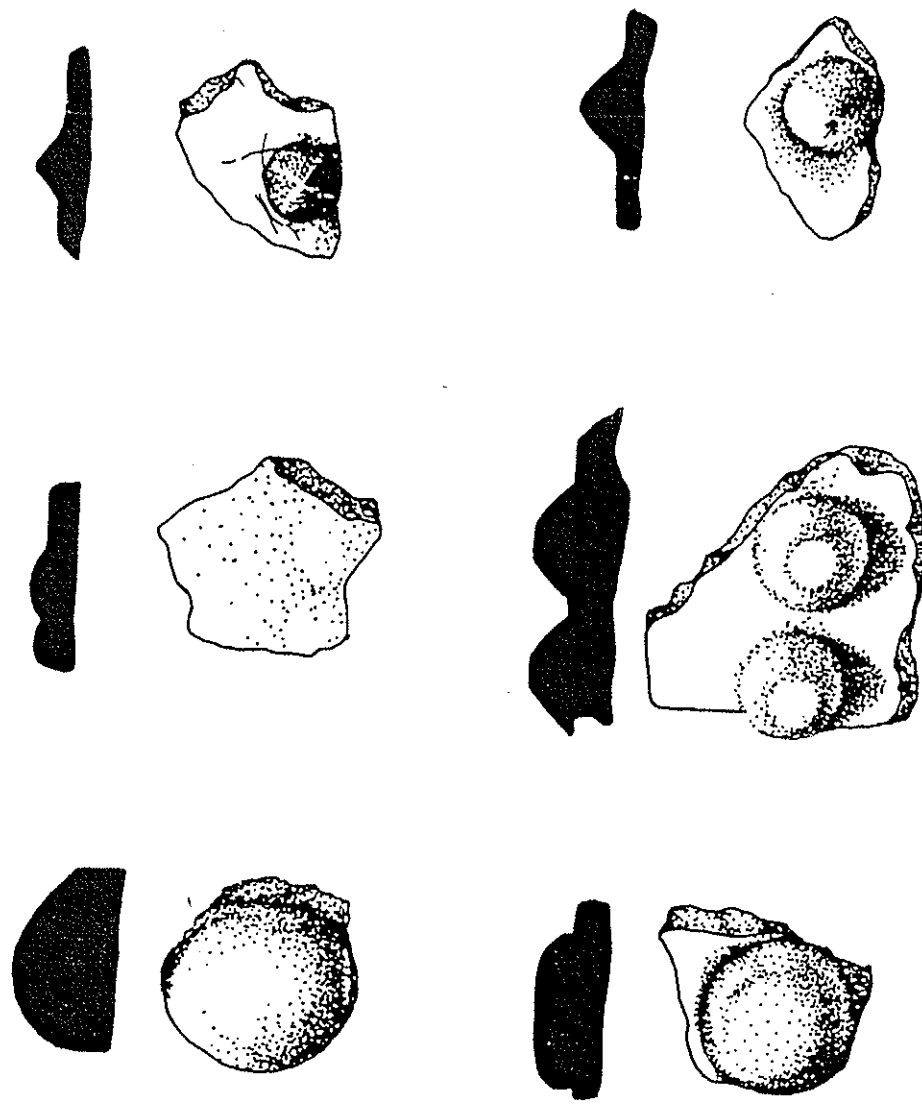

Embossed nipple decoration forms

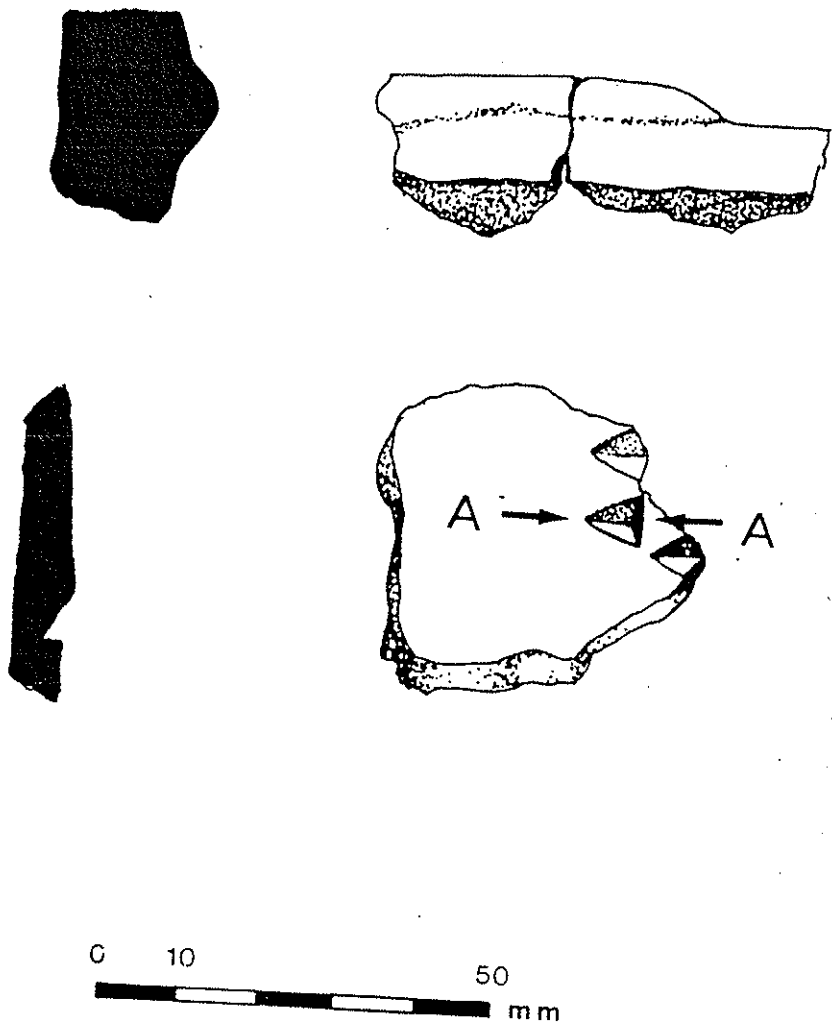

Embossed bar/rib and triangular wedge forms

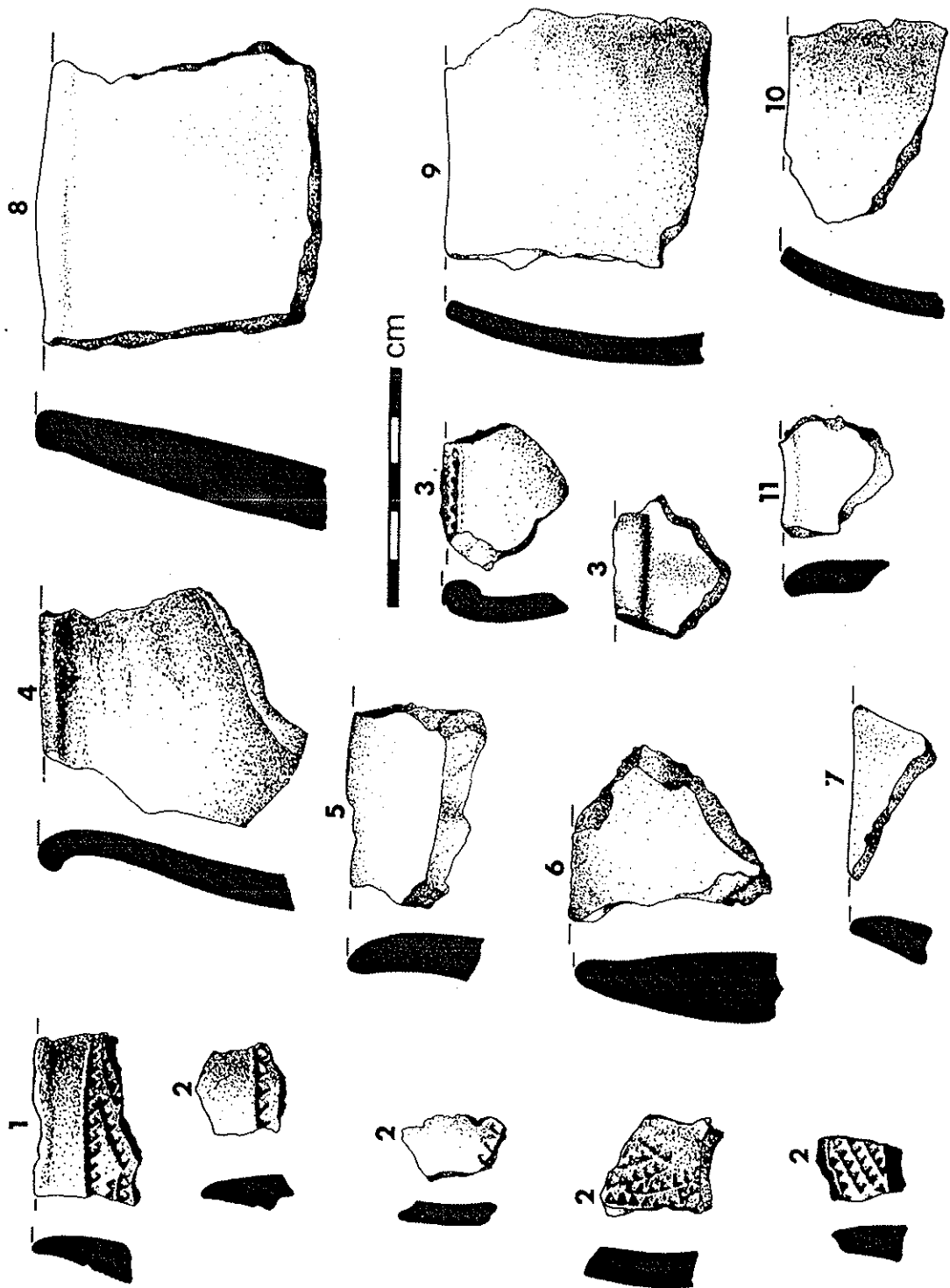

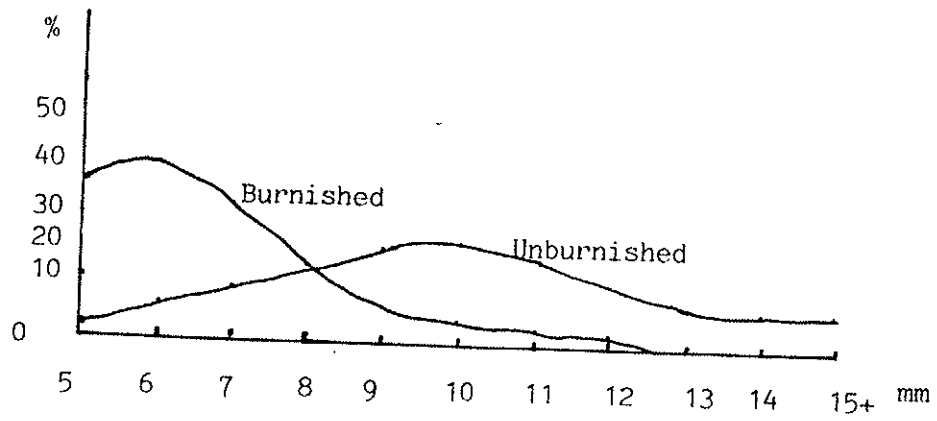

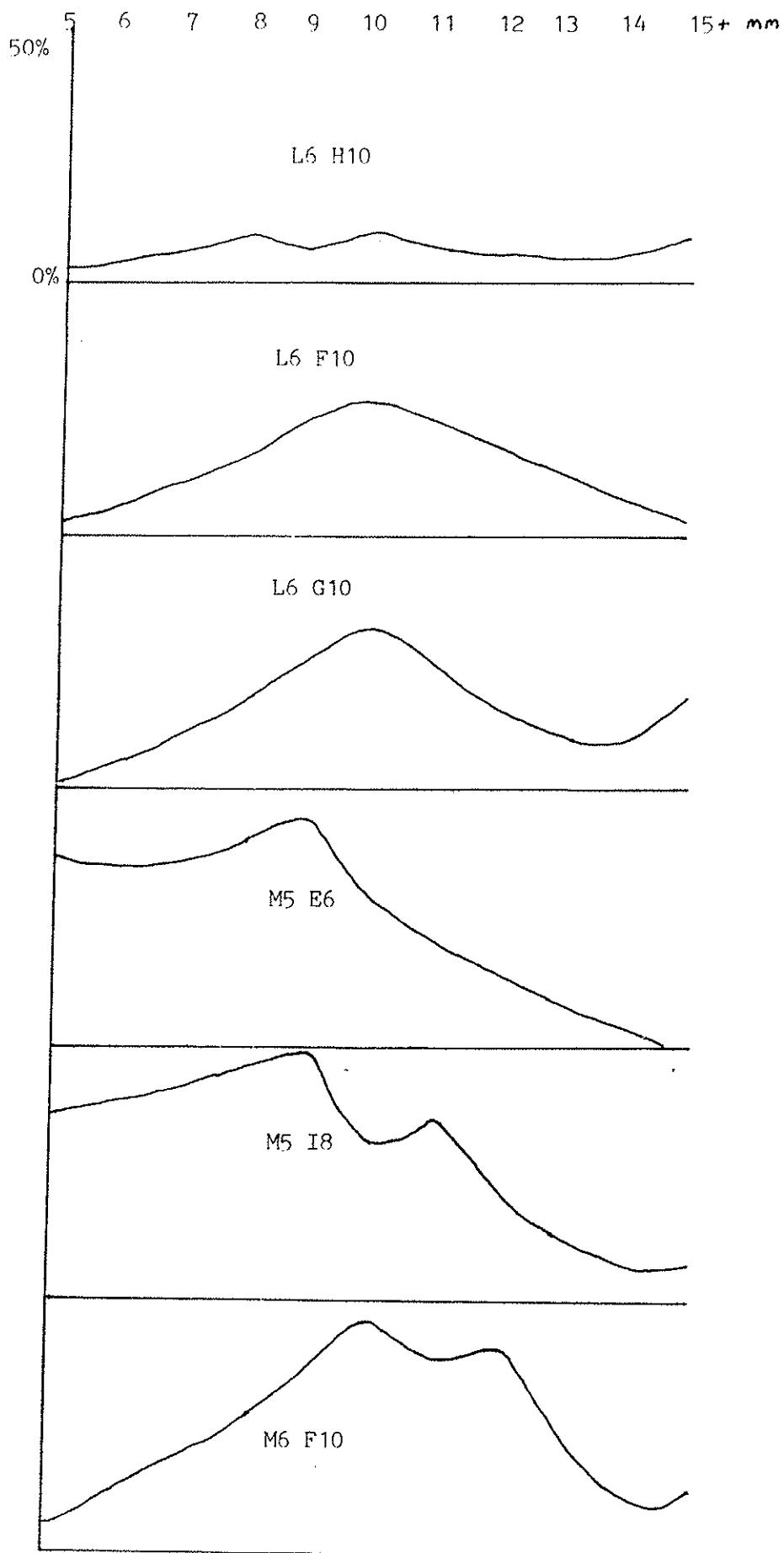
