Permission is hereby given to Prof J.E. Parkington

of University of Cape Town

to undertake the following work, subject to the safety measures published in Government Notice No. R522 of 3.4.1970 and reprinted on the reverse hereof, and the following terms, conditions, restrictions and directions:

The removal of daga samples from various structures on Mgungundlovo, Zululand for the purposes of archaeomagnetic analysis.

CONDITIONS:

- 1) The precise position of each sample both within the various structures and on the site as a whole must be recorded.
- 2) All samples and data relating thereto must be lodged with the Department of Archaeology, University of Cape Town.
- 3) A report on the removal of the samples must be submitted to the National Monuments Council by 30 April 1978 and a final report on the results of the experiment by 30 April 1979.
- 4) Reprints of all papers resulting from this work must be lodged with the National Monuments Council.
- 5) Conditions imposed by owners or occupiers of land must be observed.
- 6) This permit should be shown at a Police Station near the scene of activity.

- 2) All samples and data relating thereto must be lodged with the Department of Archaeology, University of Cape Town.
- 3) A report on the removal of the samples must be submitted to the National Monuments Council by 30 April 1978 and a final report on the results of the experiment by 30 April 1979.
- 4) Reprints of all papers resulting from this work must be lodged with the National Monuments Council.
- 5) Conditions imposed by owners or occupiers of land must be observed.
- 6) This permit should be shown at a Police Station near the scene of activity.

This permit lapses on 30 April 1978.
