Mbonambi Tribe, under Chief Manqamu, Lower Umfolosi District.

The remnant of an aboriginal tribe which submitted to Tshaka, and was allowed to remain in occupation of its old tribal lands, i.e., those they now occupy, which adjoin the Mtetwa District. The tribe can trace its history for some generations back. The tribe paid hut tax in 1903 on 404 huts, viz., £282 16s.

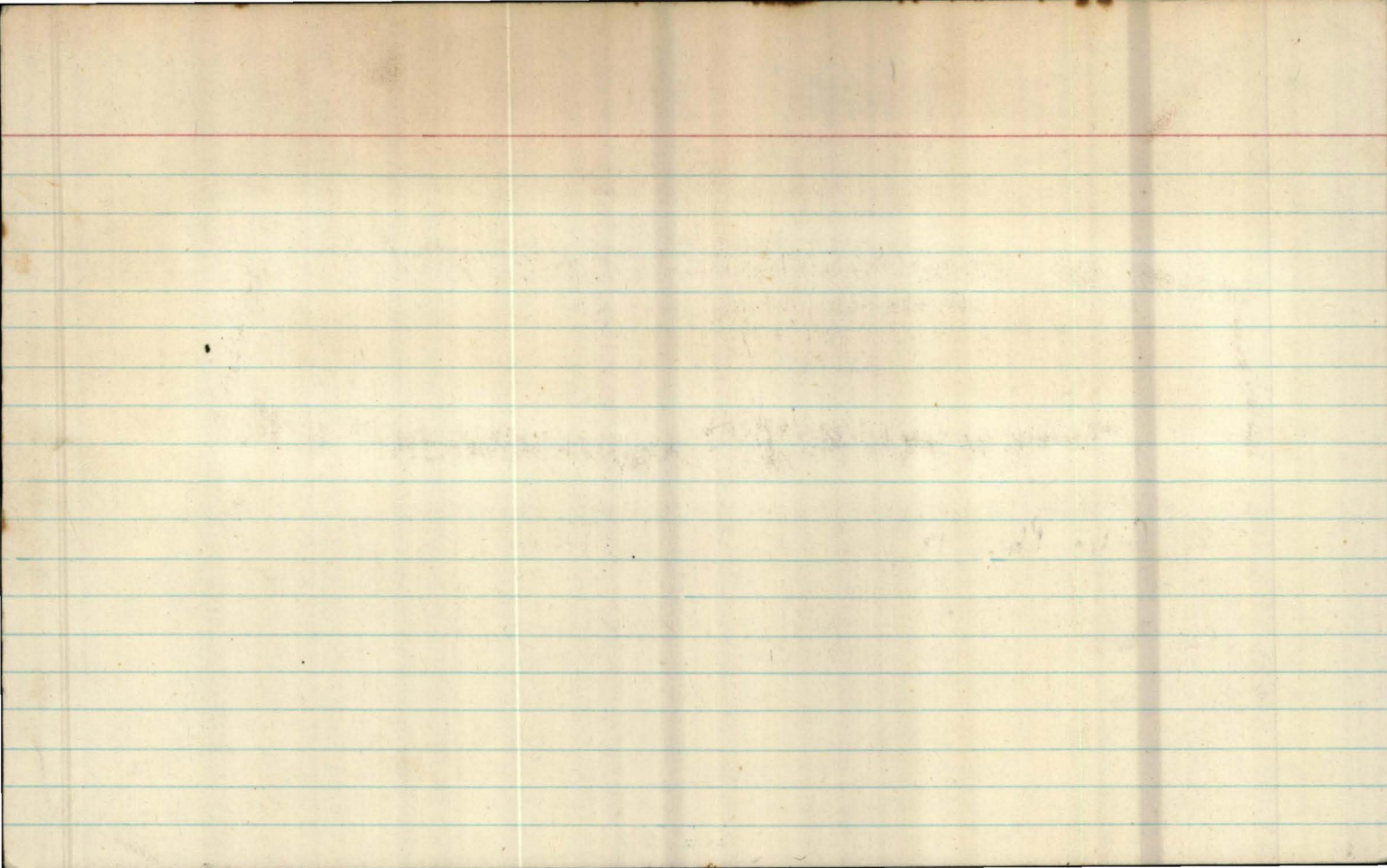

The history of this tribe is identical with that of the Mbonambi (No. 7). Their tribal lands adjoin those of the Mtetwa on the west, and those of the Mbonambi on the south. The tribe paid hut tax in 1903 for 329 huts, viz., £230 6s.
