Seem to have been closely connected to the Tembu's. Jobe was the chief in Shaka's time and was befriended by him as they both sat on the same hill top to watch the Zulu defeat by Ngoza of the Tembu. After the Tembu fled some stayed and went under Jobe. He managed to keep in good favour with Shaka* and Dingane and although he ran into some trouble over cattle with Mpande and the Boers (See Bird I 581) He managed to leave and heir, Mondise, father of Matshamna, who after the trouble with John Shepstone took political asylum in Zululand.

* And was granted an "estate" from the Tugela/Buffel Mnyati to the Drakenberg later Tembus came under Jobe's wing

ATB 261. Son of Mondise and Chief of the Sitole took refuge in Natal after trouble with authorities. His heir was his son Manzekofi.

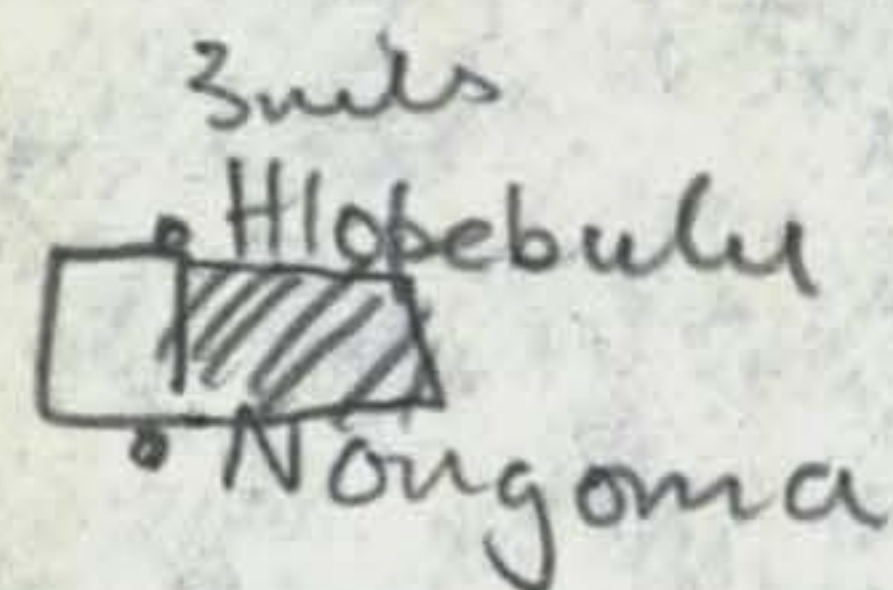
