Seem to have been closely connected to the Tembu's. Jobe was the chief in Shaka's time and was befriended by him as they both sat on the same hill top to wather the Zulu defeat by Ngoza of the Tembu After the Tembu fled same stayed and went under Jobe. He managed to keep in good favour with Shaka and Dingane and although he ran into some trouble over cattle with Lande and the Boers (See Bird I 581) He managed to leave and heir Mondise, father of Matshamna, who after the trouble with John hepselone took political asylum in Zululand.
