Ntungwa Nguni Might have formed the 'nose' of the Bantu 'procession' when a section made off to the Cape and became Xhosa and others remained behind in the Vryheid district. About 1700 moved to the coast and split - a section remaining up-country, subjecting themselves to the Buthelezi, south of the upper White Umfolosi on the Buthelezi Mbata border. The others moved to the Ntseleni stream but were conquered by Dingsiwayo when they were ruled by Jama of Mnisi, who was regent for Ndina who ruled as vassal to Dingiswayo and then to Shaka. Somehow the sons fought for the heirship but the line became extinct. A section resided on the north side of the lower Umhlatusi. (See Somopos)

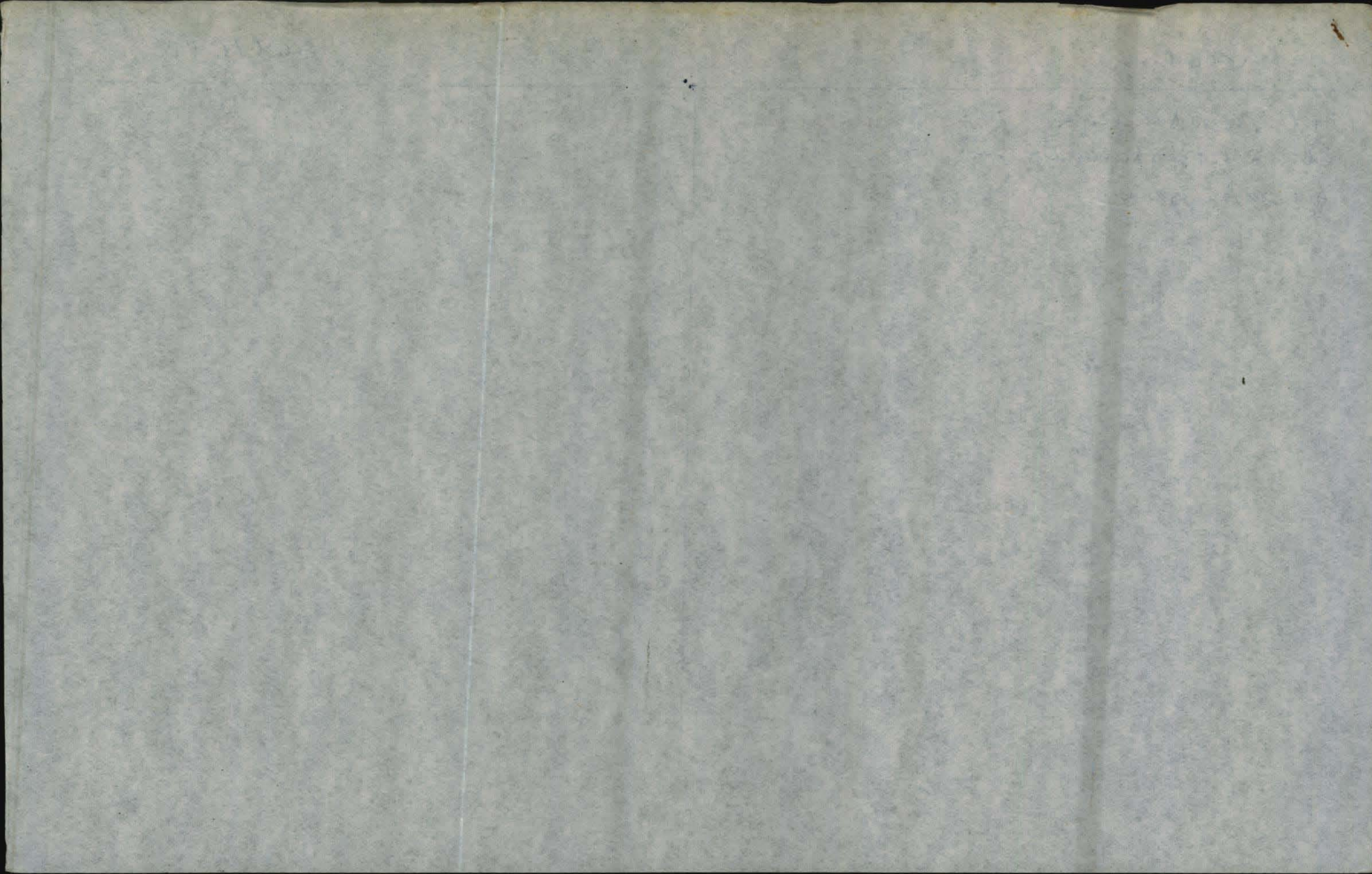

ATB243 "The present head of the coastal Tembus is Msiyana, son of Somopo, son Sikala, son of Bacile. In Mpande's time Somopo was a favourite of the Zulu King, so much so that he was appointed headman of this district and entrusted with the guardianship and 'education' of Cetshwayo.... This will probably explain the assumption of the supreme power since then among the coast Tembus by the family of Bacile.
