



Commissioner and magistrate Gibson agree that country between Bl Umf and Ivuna and line marked x x x x on map never formed part of Z's land before the war. his info was obtianed from Mankulumana Mgamule and Siziba. 'Usuthu' lived here such as the followers of Umtumbu, Uombe Mgamule onyama Ziwetu and others.

To the north - east of this thex chiefly in the vicinty of the seat of the Magistracy and between it and the Mkusana (Palaza?) on their own behalf for such headmen as Makedama, Umjwapuna, Manyosi, Sayingana or on behlaf of their allies like those who have separated from Z like Haiana or Fokoti.
